INTENDED USE

The GH935850 Maxi Lift Bariatric Trapeze is intended to assist in repositioning oneself in bed.

☆ WARNING: The Trapeze is intended to be used ONLY as an assistive device — that is, to enable patients to more easily and safely reposition themselves. It is not intended to bear entire body weight.

UNPACKING

- 1. Open carton and carefully remove contents.
- 2. Check for any obvious damage to the carton or its contents. If damage is evident, DO NOT USE. Contact carrier / distributor for further instruction.


ASSEMBLY

Required tools: Two ⁹/16" wrenches or sockets, two ³/4" wrenches or sockets


△ WARNING! Ensure trapeze is installed on level floor. Failure to set up properly may damage the trapeze and cause personal injury to users or attendants.

Setup

- 1. Unfold the base and stand the frame up as shown at right.
- 2. Install two 1/2-20-UNF x 2 3/4" hex head bolts and two 1/2-20-UNF thin lock nuts on each side as shown. Use two 3/4" wrenches to tighten all four bolts and nuts.
- 3. Slide boom over trapeze frame and install two 3/8-16-UNF x 2 1/4" hex head bolts and two 3/8-16-UNF lock nuts. Use two 9/16" wrenches to tighten both bolts and nuts.
- 4. Slide trapeze bar and strap assembly over boom and adjust to desired height by shortening or lengthening strap.
- ▲ WARNING! Pass the strap through the buckle <u>only</u> using the method shown at right. Strap assembly using any other method could cause the strap to fail.
- △ WARNING! When adjusting strap for desired trapeze bar height, ensure there are at least two inches of strap left on either end of the buckle, as shown at right.
- A WARNING! If strap becomes torn or frayed, replace it immediately.




trapeze handle webbing buckle

Transporting the Trapeze

Info: The trapeze may be free standing or anchored to the floor using the four brackets provided.

- 1. To use the transport wheels, use two 3/4" wrenches to remove the 1/2-20-UNF x 2 3/4" hex head bolt and thin lock nuts that secure the trapeze to the base on each side.
- 2. Fold the base up.
- 3. Tilt trapeze 15-25° back as shown at right and carefully roll to new location.
- 2. After transporting trapeze, reassemble base bolts and tighten (as described in **Setup**, step 2).



△ WARNING! Moving the trapeze on the transport wheels can be very dangerous. Use extreme care! The person moving the trapeze must be able to handle the weight or have an assistant to help. Do not tilt the frame more than 25°, as shown above. Do not let the center of gravity become too low. Maintain a firm grip on the trapeze.

TRAPEZE OPERATION

- △ WARNING: Before use, ensure trapeze is correctly and securely assembled, and all clamps and fasteners are tight.
- △ WARNING: The Trapeze is intended to be used ONLY as an assistive device that is, to enable patients to more easily and safely reposition themselves. It is not intended to bear entire body weight.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

△ WARNING: During use, ensure trapeze components are securely fastened at all times.

Cleaning

Use a soft cloth, dampened with water and a mild NON-ABRASIVE detergent (household cleaner, soapy water, or hospital grade disinfectant), to clean the trapeze.

LIMITED WARRANTY SCOPE OF WARRANTY

Trapeze frame:.....two years

All other durable components not listed above:.....one year

The applicable warranty period shall commence from date of shipment to the original customer, unless there is an expiration date on the component in which case the warranty shall expire on the earlier of warranty period or the expiration date.

OBTAINING WARRANTY SERVICE

This limited warranty shall only apply to defects that are reported to the Distributor from whom the Customer purchased the product within the applicable warranty period. If there is not a Distributor, you must contact GF directly by calling 1.770.368.4700, sending a fax request to 1.770.368.2386, or by e-mailing a request to cs@grahamfield.com. Specific directions will be provided by the Customer Service Representative. Failure to abide by the specific directions will result in denial of the warranty claim.
